## History



- The first school in our town was opened in 1924. The construction of a new building started in 1928 and the classes in the new building commenced in January 1929.
- The second stage was started on 6 September, 2004 in the first outbuilding with 6 classrooms.
- In September 2014, the second outbuilding with 5 classrooms and a new school gymnasium were opened.

Nine-year primary school (5 grades of the 1st stage, 4 grades of the 2nd stage)

## The school parts:

Primary school capacity - 310 pupils

Afterschool care +school club capacity - 116 pupils

School canteen capacity - 350 pupils

- The school is located in Strančice, 25 km from Prague, the capital of the Czech Republic.
- It is situated in a beautiful landscape with varied countryside. Diverse and broadleaved woodlands provide perfect the environment for relaxation.
- The town of Strančice has a good access to the transport network located in the vicinity of the D1 highway, there is a train station on the line Prague-Benešov and our town is linked to the Prague integrated transport system.





- The teaching takes place in three interconnected buildings.
- The school equipment is in line with new education trends, interactive boards are in each classroom.
- P.E. classes and sports activities are held in the new gymnasium, outdoor sports ground in front of the school and at a local football field.







- In the school garden, there is a wooden classroom which is used for outdoor classes, weather permitting.
- In the afternoon it is available for afterschool activities.







 The catering is provided by the school's own kitchen and canteen. We cook healthy meals.

- We employ 30 persons. There are 17 teachers, of which 2 are men.
- The teachers are committed to continuous training and enhancing their qualifications.
- In our school we promote a friendly working atmosphere, we meet at joint school events as well as outside work.









- Our school follows the school education program "School for a child, a child for the school". The tuition of English begins as early as in the 1<sup>st</sup> grade, the tuition of German or Russian language in the 7<sup>th</sup> grade.
- Great attention is paid to reading literacy, which involves activities like the Andersen night, admission to a reading community and a particularly close cooperation with the local library.
- The school organizes swimming courses for the pupils of the 2<sup>nd</sup> grade.
- 1 week ski course is organized for the students in the 7<sup>th</sup> grade, which takes place in the Czech Republic or abroad, mostly in Austria.







- Individual educational plans for children with special educational needs are produced in close cooperation with parents, we promote talented children. Our school employs a special pedagogue who organizes group corrective trainings for children with specific learning disorders and a school psychologist. The school cooperates with an educational psychology counselling centre in Strančice.
- Talented children are systematically prepared for various types of grammar schools (Czech Gymnasium).







• A number or events are organized for children throughout the year to diversify their classes and school experience, many of which became traditional. These include tours, trips, Young Spectator Club, sports tournaments, musical performances, literature and recitation contest, project days, thematic workshops, sales exhibition of student work, curative stays and round trips around Bohemia, school leaving ceremony for the pupils of the 9<sup>th</sup> grade.







 Parents are welcome and are important partners for our school. The School Fan Club operates in our school whose aim is to support school activities. The school organizes a lot of joint events for parents and grandparents.







Our primary school is a school of so called "family type", we know all our children and respect the individual needs of any child.
